

## Pedorthics

Pedorthists are certified healthcare professionals with specialized education and training in the care of the lower limbs through observation of surface anatomy, palpation, gait and range of motion. This would include any health-related factor which can have a debilitating impact on the function of the limb. Pedorthists are also trained in the manufacturing, fitting and modification of foot appliances and footwear.

The Diploma in Pedorthics will give students the knowledge and skills required to succeed in their career and write the C. Ped (C) certification exam. This is the only program of its kind in Canada.

# Path 2: Bridging Route Online // Practicum // Full-time // Part-Time May start

The bridging program provides an alternate path for students with science related backgrounds who do not meet the admission requirements for the Diploma in Pedorthics. This comprehensive four-month online program covers biomechanics, exercise physiology, systemic functional anatomy and introduction to athletic injuries, preparing students who do not have a kinesiology degree to enrol in the Diploma in Pedorthics. Upon successful completion of the Bridging component, students will receive pre-approved entry to the Diploma in Pedorthics beginning in September
