On Leave Status

Registrants On Leave are those who have taken a leave of absence, approved by The College of Pedorthics of Canada (CPC) who are not working in the profession, but who wish to maintain a link to the profession. On Leave Registrants can hold On Leave status for no more than two (2) consecutive years. If an extension beyond two years is required, the On Leave Registrant must submit a letter addressed to the CPC board for approval. Extensions may be granted in one (1) year increments to a max of four consecutive years total.

The above is in accordance with the CPC By-Law no.4, subsection 4.

DECLARATION

A Registrant with On Leave status shall:

- a) maintain the continuing education point (CEP) minimums specific to their designation
- b) continue to pay CPC dues at a reduced rate

A Registrant with On Leave status shall not:

- a) engage in providing direct patient care;
- b) supervise Pedorthic Candidates;
- c) use their professional designation for employment purposes;
