2024 Registrant Renewals

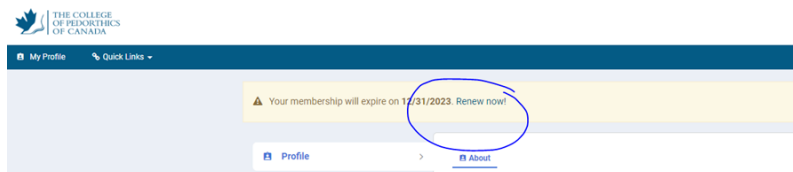
Dear CPC Registrants,

The 2024 College of Pedorthics of Canada (CPC) registrant renewal invoices are now available online. Membership fees are due by **January 1st, 2024**. Payments received after January 1, 2024 are subject to a \$50 (plus GST/HST) late fee.

Please follow the four steps below to renew your CPC Membership:

- **Log-In:** Log-in your CPC registrant portal with your personal username and password [HERE](#). If you require a password reset, contact the CPC office immediately: info@cpedcs.ca.
- **Renew and pay online:** Renew your membership by clicking: **'Renew Now'** at the top of the screen in the Registrant Area or *Manage Prolife* pages. You can choose to pay your membership online by credit card in real-time or you can send a cheque for the full amount to the CPC office. If paying by credit card, you may choose to pay in 12-month installments.
**Please note that if you are currently on the installment schedule for 2023, you will not be able to renew for 2024 until your last payment has been processed.*



- **Confirm Proof of Professional Liability Insurance (PPL):** All members are required to confirm insurance coverage during the renewal process. If you are NOT insured with BMS, please upload a PDF copy of your proof of 1 million personal liability insurance to your membership profile. - **Update Profile:** Lastly, please click on the 'Manage Profile' link to review your current profile information and make any changes, as necessary.
