It highlights a comprehensive assessment, development of treatment plans, and design and manufacturing. Please see below:

Canadian Certified Pedorthist – C. Ped (C)

These health professionals can provide:

- A comprehensive assessment of the lower limb that includes postural and gait analysis, range of motion testing, palpation, special testing, footwear analysis, a detailed history and review of potentially complicating health factors.
- A treatment plan for musculoskeletal injuries, medical conditions, disabilities, and diseases affecting the lower limb, that is developed following a comprehensive assessment and incorporates non-invasive treatment options to improve patient biomechanics, comfort and mobility. A treatment plan is implemented with a patientcentred approach, including patient education and shared decision making. It is evaluated over time in conjunction with other healthcare professionals when necessary.
